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# APPROVAL OF 2023-2024 TUITION AND FEES & COMMON AND UNIVERSITY / PROGRAM SPECIFIC FEES

### Action Requested: Consider approval of:

- 1. The proposed tuition and mandatory fees for the 2023-24 academic year as outlined in this memorandum, effective with the Fall 2023 session.
- 2. The allocation of the Regent universities mandatory student fees for the 2023-24 academic year as provided on page 8.
- 3. The proposed Common and University / Program Specific Fees for the 2023-24 academic year as provided on pages 15-19.

**Executive Summary:** Consistent with the Board's strategic plan, determining and fulfilling appropriate resource needs are essential in providing high quality public education, cutting-edge research, and needed public services. Predictability, transparency and long-term planning strategies are woven throughout the plan.

The Board considers the total resources necessary to maintain and strengthen the Regent universities. Regent institutions need adequate support from all sources, while promoting the effective use of resources to meet institutional missions and to maintain the quality of education lowans expect. In recent years, the Board has collectively examined the two main resource components available – tuition and state appropriations – as well as the reallocations/efficiencies necessary to strengthen lowa's public universities.

At its September 2022 meeting, the Board requested an appropriations increase for FY 2024 (2023-2024 academic year) of \$32.0 million for the general university appropriations that support Regent higher education. As enacted by the General Assembly, the general university appropriations remain flat for FY 2024 (0% increase) when compared to the current year. However, the legislature did appropriate additional education-related special purpose funding totaling \$7.1 million for the College of Nursing at SUI (\$2.8M), STEM workforce initiatives at ISU (\$2.8M), and teacher student recruitment efforts at UNI (\$1.5M).

While considering the state support, operating costs that may be absorbed through efficiencies and reallocations, and the expected inflationary impact to higher education budgets, the proposed tuition rates in this memorandum for the 2023-24 academic year includes base undergraduate resident increases of 3.5% at each university (\$305 at SUI; \$304 at ISU; \$285 at UNI). The universities also propose varying tuition rates for non-resident, graduate and professional students as well as differential rates for certain programs. A summary of mandatory fees is provided on page 4 and a comprehensive list of all proposed tuition and fee rates for each university is on pages 11-14.

### **Undergraduate Tuition**

The proposed 2023-24 base tuition rates for undergraduate resident and nonresident students are provided below.

Funding from the proposed tuition increases will help address growing financial challenges including inflationary cost increases, recruiting and retaining faculty and staff in national markets, meeting collective bargaining terms (e.g. AFSCME & UNI United Faculty), deferred maintenance needs in academic facilities, and student financial aid to provide higher education opportunities to more students.

In addition to the base undergraduate resident and nonresident tuition increases, SUI and ISU request the following differential tuition rates for specific higher cost programs as described below. Assessing tuition in this manner aligns costs where they are incurred rather than spreading those costs over the entire student population.

#### STATE UNIVERSITY OF IOWA

• The Radiation Sciences Program of the Carver College of Medicine is requesting a tuition increase of \$1,394 for on-campus resident and non-resident undergraduate students for Fall 2023. This is the year-one request of a three-year phasing in of tuition increases to ultimately reach a balanced budget. The increase is needed to fully fund the Radiation Sciences Program which is currently running a budget deficit. The program is essential to SUI's mission and the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics, as it provides healthcare personnel in the areas of diagnostic imaging and radiation therapy. There are critical shortages of these healthcare personnel. A review of peer institutions with Undergraduate Baccalaureate Degrees in Radiation Sciences demonstrates that SUI's target tuition is comparable, particularly when looking at programs associated with academic medical centers.

#### IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY

• ISU's Ivy College of Business proposes to align tuition rates for sophomore students majoring in business with junior and senior business majors over a three-year period. The college proposes and increase of \$1,010 for applicable resident students and \$1,192 for non-residents beginning Fall 2023. Once fully implemented, the differential tuition rate structure will be further simplified for sophomore, junior, and senior-level undergraduate classifications in these degree programs. Sophomore business students have intensive hands-on or experiential components (such as formal and informal interactions with the faculty, involvement in industry consulting projects and case-based learning, smaller section sizes similar to upper-level students, and access to a growing number of programs and increased opportunities for double-majors, certificates and minors). Almost half of business sophomores already enroll in 300- or 400- level courses and this proposal will allow students to more easily add a second business major, minor or certificate.

#### **Graduate and Professional Tuition**

The proposed 2023-24 base tuition and fee rates for graduate resident and nonresident students are as follows:

Variances from the base rate proposals for certain graduate programs for SUI and ISU are provided below.

#### STATE UNIVERSITY OF IOWA

- College of Law: The College of Law proposes a 3.5% increase in the non-resident tuition rate.
- Carver College of Medicine (CCOM):
  - MD Program: The CCOM proposes no increase in the resident and non-resident tuition rate for MD students.
  - Master of Science in Athletic Training: The MS in Athletic Training program proposes a 2.5% increase for both resident and non-resident students.
  - The Doctor of Physical Therapy proposes no increase in tuition for both resident and nonresident students.
  - Master of Clinical Nutrition: The MS in Clinical Nutrition program proposes a 2% increase in the tuition rate for resident students to allow the program to remain competitive.
- College of Nursing: To remain competitive, the College of Nursing proposes no increase in the tuition rates for resident and for non-resident graduate students.
- College of Pharmacy: The College of Pharmacy proposes a small increase of \$138 in the tuition
  rates for resident and non-resident students in the PharmD program to offset some additional
  costs. The intent is to stem the loss of quality students resulting in smaller class sizes by keeping
  tuition rates competitive.

#### IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY

- Veterinary Medicine ISU proposes a 5% increase to Veterinary Medicine resident students and 3.75% for nonresident students enrolled in the highly ranked program. Veterinary education is an intense mix of classroom instruction and clinical learning in both teaching laboratories and a modern referral teaching hospital. The additional revenue will enable ISU to deliver state-of-the art learning experiences for veterinary students, and a positive working environment for faculty and staff; to maintain and upgrade diagnostic equipment, imaging equipment, and medical supplies, while incorporating new technological advances; and to support faculty as leaders in veterinary curriculum development and teaching.
- Executive MBA Program The proposed rates for these programs remain flat (\$0 increase) with the current year. This program has a defined two-year curriculum directed at a cohort-based demographic of senior business leaders.

#### Inflation

Inflation impacts higher education in the same manner it affects other segments of the economy. Since the Board determines tuition increases well in advance of the actual expenditure of funds, the Board has utilized inflation projections. In conjunction with the Federal Open Market Committee meeting on March 21-22, 2023, committee members submitted their inflation projections for calendar years 2023 and 2024. Based on these projections which exclude food and energy due to their volatility, core inflation is expected to range from 3.5% - 4.1% in 2023 and 2.1% - 3.1% in 2024.

The proposed tuition rates at all three universities combined are projected to generate \$29 million in incremental revenue for FY 2024, approximately 1.8% of the current total general education fund operating budget.

#### **Mandatory Fees**

Mandatory fees, charged to each student, provide a distinct resource to respond to specific needs of students. Provided below are the proposed 2023-24 mandatory fees for each university.

#### UNIVERSITY OF IOWA

SUI proposes an overall increase in mandatory student fees of \$306.

- New Iowa Memorial Union (IMU) Facilities Fee: As presented to the Board as part of the 10-year capital plan, SUI is planning a major renovation to the IMU. SUI requests a new annual mandatory fee of \$240 per undergraduate student and \$200 per graduate/professional student to support these planned improvements. The undergraduate and graduate/professional student governments have provided letters of support for the improvements and the fees.
- Technology As reflected above, the University recommends a 5.3% increase to all Technology Fees. The net new revenue generated from these increases will fund inflationary increases in IT expenditures that support students.
- Student Services SUI requests a \$5 increase to the student services fee to address a critical student staffing shortfall and the dramatic increase in fuel costs.
- Student Activities On behalf of the undergraduate and graduate student governments, SUI
  requests a \$2 increase in the activities fee to provide additional support services whose basic
  needs (food, clothing) are not being met.
- Health The proposed \$17 increase to the Health Fee will support the increased demand for Student Health services and higher costs to provide those services.
- Mental Health The proposed Mental Health Fee increase of \$3 will fund the remaining 50% of the Behavioral Health Clinical Manager that provides direct services to students. University Counseling Services already has half of the funding needed for the position.
- Recreation A \$10 increase is proposed to offset increased operational and programming costs of the recreation facilities and decreased numbers of non-student memberships.

**IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY** 

ISU proposes an overall increase in mandatory student fees of \$60.

- Technology High quality, reliable, and accessible technology is fundamental to all components
  of ISU's mission. Information Technology Services (ITS) enhances the student experience,
  protects student privacy, and supports digital accessibility by way of modern and useful
  technology and software. ITS is requesting an annual Student Technology Fee increase of \$14
  per student to support the increase in student-related software license costs.
- Health Student utilization of the Thielen Student Health Center (TSHC) continues to significantly increase despite decreased enrollment. Over the last six years, utilization of the TSHC has increased 24%, including increased complexity and severity of student needs. TSHC has seen an increase of 240% in complex/chronic diagnoses such as depression, anxiety and diabetes. The proposed \$15 increase will support lowa State's strategic priority of continuing to promote optimal health of our university community by providing funding for a full-time psychologist, increased market demand for healthcare professionals and the increasing cost for medical supplies.
- Student Activities The student activities fee enables the Student Government Association (SGA) to fund numerous student priorities. The proposed \$10 increase will cover some inflationary effects on SGA priorities and provide additional funding for the Iowa State Daily newspaper.
- Student Services This student fee, university support, the City of Ames, and fare box revenue
  jointly fund CyRide. The proposed \$11 increase will be directed to the CyRide component of the
  services fee and is needed for fuel and labor cost increases as well as maintaining quality and
  safe service due to increasing demand.
- Building Fees The Memorial Union (MU) serves as a hub for student life and activities. The
  requested \$10 increase for the MU will stabilize their budget and keep up with inflationary
  measures which directly impact their ability to reinvest in MU's infrastructure.

#### University of Northern Iowa

UNI proposes an overall increase in mandatory student fees of \$32.

- Technology UNI proposes a \$9.50 increase to the technology fee to support the maintenance and expansion of institutional technology support systems and services including the University's learning management system (LMS), lecture-capture system, video conferencing services, polling systems, testing services, classroom technologies, data network connectivity and services, assistive technologies, computer laboratories, software subscriptions, online content and learning systems, and several other services.
- Health Student Health Services ensures student access to essential health services, including
  medical, counseling and wellness services. The number of visits for counseling and office visits
  has increased in recent years and this funding is vital to continue to provide these services to our
  students. A \$2.50 increase to the Health Fee is proposed to support Student Health Services.
- Student Activities The proposed \$1.50 increase will help provide revenue to sustain current programs and services including student organizations, fine arts programs, student newspaper, and activities sponsored by the Campus Activities Board and Student Life.
- Student Services The proposed student services fee reflects an \$3.00 increase to provide needed revenue to support intercollegiate athletics
- Building The proposed \$1 increase to UNI's building fee will help address deferred maintenance needs.
- Recreation UNI proposes a \$14.50 increase to the recreation fee will allow Recreation Services to maintain existing programs and services for students.

## **Estimated Cost of Attendance**

<u>lowa Code</u> §262.9(19) requires the Board to publish the estimated total cost of attending the Regent universities, including room and board and other costs, at the same time that it publishes final tuition and mandatory fees.

Based on the proposed base tuition rates, room and board rates, and other costs, the following table estimates the total cost of attendance for a resident undergraduate student.

Other costs, as quantified for financial aid calculations, include the universities' estimates of student costs for books, supplies, transportation and personal expenses.

lowa Code §262.34B authorizes a student fee committee comprised of five students and five employees at each university to make recommendations for the distribution of revenues from student activity/service fees to the university president. The allocation proposals are consistent with the recommendations of the student fee committees. Building fees are allocated among enterprises to ensure minimum bond coverage ratios are met.

The statute requires Board approval of the allocation of these student fees. Proposed fee allocations represent efforts to provide opportunities for students to participate in student organizations and activities.

### Common and University / Program Specific Fees

Common and University / Program Specific Fees are assessed only to students that use these services based on their programs, interests, or needs. Students may pay one or more fees as presented in this memorandum for the direct costs associated with using additional miscellaneous services provided by the universities. These fees are separate from tuition and mandatory fees. The Board received the first reading of the proposed Common and University / Program Specific Fees rates at its May 11, 2023 meeting.

#### Part-time Tuition and Mandatory Fees:

The proposed 2023-24 part-time tuition and fee rates for resident and nonresident undergraduate and graduate courses at the three universities are consistent with the proposed tuition and mandatory fee rates for full-time students. Resident and nonresident rates for part-time students with differential tuition are based on the corresponding full-time tuition rates.

Undergraduate and professional part-time tuition and mandatory fees are based on 12 credit hours, while graduate part-time rates are based on 9 credit hours.

Some proposed mandatory fees for part-time students as well as summer sessions may vary among the universities as described below.

#### Student Health fees

 ISU – full fee assessed to all students taking 5 or more hours per semester; no fee assessed to student taking less than 5 credit hours

#### Student Health Facility fees

ISU – full fee assessed to all students regardless of the number of credit hours taken

#### All other mandatory fees

For undergraduate students:

 SUI, ISU and UNI – assessed at 75% of the full semester rates for 6 through 11 hours and at 50% for less than 6 credit hours

### For graduate students:

- SUI assessed at 75% of full semester rates for 4 through 8 hours and 50% for less than 4 credit hours
- ISU and UNI assessed at 75% of full semester rates for 5 through 8 hours and 50% for less than 5 credit hours

#### Summer school

- SUI & ISU computer fees assessed at full semester rate; maximum of other fees assessed at 50%
- UNI assessed at 50% of the full semester rate
