SUBJECT: Fall Enrollment Counts

Below are the official Fall 2009 enrollments counts from ISU, UNI, and SUI. The numbers will be released to the public tomorrow by the institutions. The total Fall 2009 enrollment is 71,353 which is an increase of 1,028 (+1.5%) from last fall - ISU and UNI had enrollment increases and SUI had an enrollment decrease. There was an increase of 912 undergraduate students; an increase of 198 graduate students; and a decrease of 82 professional students.

UNIVERSITY OF IOWA

The total is 30,328, a decrease of 233 (-0.8%) from Fall 2008. There was a decrease of 249 (-1.2%) undergraduate students; an increase of 131 (+2.3%) graduate students, and a decrease of 115 (-2.8%) professional students from the prior fall semester.

IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY

The total is 27,945, an increase of 1,089 (+4.1%) from Fall 2008. There was an increase of 914 (+4.2%) undergraduate students; an increase of 142 (+3.0%) graduate students, and an increase of 33 (+6.2%) professional students from the prior fall semester.

UNIVERSITY OF NORTHERN IOWA

The total is 13,080, an increase of 172 (+1.3%) from Fall 2008. There was an increase of 247 (+2.2%) undergraduate students and a decrease of 75 (-4.0%) graduate students from the prior fall semester.
