This project will install a geothermal energy system for Rice Hall, the School's dormitory, to upgrade the heating system and provide central cooling for the facility. Amendment \#1 in the amount of $\$ 14,900$ to the agreement with Farris Engineering would provide construction administration services for the project. These services are typically provided by lowa State University staff for the School's capital projects. However, due to the magnitude of the Rice Hall project, the University has recommended that construction administration services be provided by the project engineers. The University has indicated that $\$ 14,900$ is a reasonable fee for these services.


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
