Merging Three The Institute for Physical Research and Technology (IPRT) has been assisting lowa companies since its founding in 1987. It currently offers Centers into One

outreach programs through the Center for Advanced Technology Development (CATD), the Iowa Demonstration Laboratory for Nondestructive Evaluation (IDL), the Iowa Companies Assistance Program (ICAP), and the Iowa Industrial Incentive Program (IIP). The University has merged these individual centers and programs into one

single, cohesive unit named IPRT Company Assistance.

The new unit will provide a seamless system to better serve lowa companies and entrepreneurs. The technical assistance and contract research services will not change, and lowa companies will continue to have access to the expertise and facilities of IPRT's world-class research
